

Students need the following supplies for the school year:

• MND Tablet PC

•

- A backpack or shoulder bag that will hold the protective case for your Tablet PC.
 - The Tablet PC (provided) case has approximate dimensions: 13 in. x 10 in. x 1 in.
- Headphones that connect to your tablet (with headphone jack or Bluetooth)
 - NOTE: Spanish and French students should have headphones with a microphone built in.
- Graphing Calculator (See separate flyer)
 - Students need to have the mini USB to USB cable that comes with the calculator in order to connect this to their tablets.
- A few pens and pencils
- A few highlighters
- Colored pencils or thin markers
- Post-it page tabs for novels
- One binder or folder with loose-leaf paper. (There may be an occasional paper document to save or a need to write something on paper.)
