# DRESS CODE



2024 - 2025

#### Dress Code

There are regular dress code days and out-of-uniform days (administrative approved jeans/sweats days). Additionally, MND requires that students have a Dressy Uniform that is appropriate for special occasions: masses and prayer services, designated assemblies, certain field trips, Capstone Presentation (seniors), interviews, press releases, and other occasions when they need to present themselves in a more "professional" manner.

#### Regular Dress Code Days

#### **Tops**

- Any official Mount Notre Dame (MND) logo top/t-shirt and/or any official MND logo sweatshirt. Sweatshirts should be
  in good repair and should not be ripped or cut.
  - o NOTE: Senior t-shirts from previous years are reserved only for that class and may not be worn.
- Coats and jackets (MND or other) are not permitted during the school day.
- Optional: Seniors may wear their official MND senior t-shirts and sweatshirts.
- Starting August 2025, students will no longer be permitted to wear hoodie sweatshirts as part of the dress code.

#### Skirts/Skorts/Pants

On any day students may wear any self-purchased navy-blue skirt or navy-blue skort provided it meets the outlined standards.

- Skirts/skorts must be solid (no stripes or accent colors) navy-blue, utilizing the navy-blue color swatch provided to families. Built-in shorts for a skort must also be navy-blue.
- Skirts/skorts must be fully skirted around the body (should look like a skirt from the front and back), without any open or overlapping sides. A small slit/notch/scallop is allowed at the sides.
- Skirts/skorts can have pleats or tiers but should not be made of mesh fabric.
- The length of the skirt/skort should be no shorter than the bottom of the student's thumb when her arms are extended straight at her side.
- Students who choose a navy-blue skirt must wear a solid navy-blue fitted (biker) short underneath that is not longer than the skirt OR a solid navy-blue fitted legging underneath that falls below the knee and is not longer than the ankle.
- Logos are not permitted at the bottom of the skirt/skort/legging but may be present on a small scale at the waistband since it will not likely be visible.

On any day students may wear any self-purchased navy-blue jogger/track pants provided they meet the outlined standards.

- Joggers/track pants must be solid (no stripes or accent colors) navy-blue, utilizing the navy-blue color swatch provided to families.
- The jogger/track pants must be structured and may not have cargo-style pockets. They must have a loose fit, not tight to the leq. In other words, they should fit like a pant, not oversized/baggy and should not be fitted or flared leggings.
- Joggers/track pants should be ankle length. They may be tapered to the ankle or straight leg (not wide leg, bootcut, flared or bell). At the ankle, the pants can have a jogger-style wide cuff band or a traditional hem. An elasticized gathering (like a retro sweat pant) is not allowable.
- Logos on the jogger/track pants may be present on a small scale at the waistband since it will not likely be visible.
- Seniors may wear their official MND senior spirit wear bottoms.

NOTE: This option replaces the uniform sweatpants and khaki pants from previous years.

#### **Footwear**

- Socks of any color or pattern may be worn.
- Shoes should be chosen with safety in mind. Some footwear is not suitable for a school environment with high traffic areas, stairwells, etc. Soft-soled slippers or slipper-like shoes are not permitted.
- Approved footwear includes rubber-soled, closed toe shoes. The back of the shoe must cover at least half of the heel or have a strap to secure the shoe on the foot. Boots are acceptable.

#### Out of Dress Code Days

- On jeans/sweats days, students may be out of uniform according to the specifications given for the day. All clothing must be in good condition, fit properly, and contain only appropriate messages.
- Shorts must be longer than any shirt/sweatshirt worn.

#### **Dressy Uniform Days**

When a student is required to be in dressy uniform, it is expected that the student is compliant with all parts of the dressy uniform dress code (tops, skirts/pants, and shoes).

#### <u>Tops</u>

- Solid white short-sleeved or long-sleeved dressy blouse. It must have a collar and may be worn untucked. The blouse may not be sheer.
- Blouses should be ironed/without excessive wrinkles.
- Undergarments must be flesh toned so as to not be visible under the blouse.
- Optional: A solid white or solid black cardigan sweater.
- NOTE: MND is researching and considering a required, MND-branded white top for the 2025 2026 school year.

#### Skirts/Pants

- Solid black skirt (knee-length, mid-calf length, or ankle-length) OR solid black pants (ankle-length or mid-calf-length).
- Pinstriped, printed, patterned, and charcoal gray skirts or pants are not permitted.
- Leggings, yoga pants, athletic stretch pants or other tight, form-fitting pants or skirts are NOT acceptable for special occasions.

#### Foot/Leg Wear

- Solid black flat "dressy" shoes with closed toes and closed heels are required (shoes may not have a white rubber platform base).
- Shoes must be dressy and have dark soles. (Think of a leather or faux-leather ballet flat.)
- Sandals, gym shoes, or other canvas shoes, moccasins, or boots are not acceptable.
- Shoes should be comfortable so they can be worn all day. Changing into non-dressy shoes is not allowable.
- Only black tights or black socks are permitted with the dressy uniform.

#### Prohibited Items (all days)

- Outdoor apparel worn indoors (including hats, bonnets, wide bands, bandanas, scarves, heavy winter jackets, rain jackets, gloves, etc.).
- Senior t-shirts from previous senior classes.
- Sweatpants or any long pants (including pajama bottoms) under skirts/skorts.
- Any item of apparel which is too short, too tight, or in disrepair.
- Students may not pull up a hood on their head in the school building.
- White out, paint, or marker, etc. may NOT be applied to any uniform item.
- Students may not carry plush toys, animals, pillows, or blankets with them in the school building. These items need to be stored in a backpack or locker.
- Purses or crossbody bags should not be worn in bathrooms or at assemblies/mass. Teachers may ask students to take off purses or crossbody bags in their classrooms at their discretion.

## MND Dress Code Updates

### Skorts/Skirts

- Any Navy Blue Skirt or Skort that follows the Dress Code Guidelines
  - o Solid Navy Blue no stripes or accent colors
  - No shorter than the tip of the thumb with arms straight at sides
  - Fully skirted no mesh
  - o Only small logo at waistband allowed
  - Skirts must be worn with Navy Blue fitted biker shorts or Navy Blue leggings
  - Skorts must have Navy Blue fitted short



### **Pants**

- Any Navy Blue Structured Jogger/Track Pant that follows the Dress Code Guidelines
  - Solid Navy Blue no stripes or accent colors
  - Not oversized/baggy
  - Not Leggings
  - o Straight, tapered or cuffed at the ankle (no wide leg)
  - o Khakis are no longer allowable



The Skort/Skirt and Pants options described above may be worn any day of the school year, with the exception of Dressy Uniform Days.

## MND Dress Code Updates

### Tops

- Choices Include:
  - Any official MND Logo Top
  - o Any official MND Logo Sweatshirt
- Starting August 2025, Hoodies will NOT be allowed to be worn during the school day



### **Shoes**

- No Changes to Shoe Dress Code
- Rubber-soled, closed toe shoes are to be worn
- The back of the shoe must cover at least half of the heel or have a strap to secure the shoe on the foot
- Soft-soled "slippers" or slipper-like shoes are not permitted
- Boots are acceptable if they fit the code



# **Dressy Uniform**

- No Changes to the Dressy Uniform for the 2024-2025 School Year
- MND will likely require a branded white top next school year
